## Citizens Police Academy, 2018

The members of the Dennis Police Department would like to invite the citizens of Dennis to participate in their 16<sup>th</sup> Citizens Police Academy. The objective of this program is offered to citizens so they may learn about and observe, first-hand, the workings of their police department. Participants will be instructed by the members of the department in a variety of subjects. These subjects will be taught in various settings and will include a ride-along. The key to the success of this program is the enthusiasm and participation that the citizens bring to our Citizen's Police Academy. The Citizen's Police Academy will be held at the Dennis Police Department Monday evenings for 11 weeks, beginning **Monday, March 19, 2017**. Sessions run from 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm. Some of the classes may be held at other locations. Each student may participate in a ride-along with an officer during their patrol. We would like all students to attend every class but we do understand that sometimes this isn't possible. In order for students to graduate, they must not miss more than two classes. Our academies are usually well-attended, and often there will be a wait-list after we cap the class at 30 participants. Please consider applying as soon as possible.
