## **\*\*IMPORTANT\*\***

All Slip and Mooring assignees are reminded to return their applications and payment in full by **MONDAY MARCH 1, 2010.**

### Applications

Please take a few minutes to carefully review your 2010 application and correct any errors or omissions. **Also, a copy of the vessels' registration or documentation, AND a copy of the Certificate of Insurance, MUST be submitted with the application.** Please be sure to fill in the draft and the size of the head or holding tank. **Please check to see if all phone numbers are correct for emergency notification.**

**Bass River Mooring holders** – please add in all the information regarding your mooring (type, weight, length of chain, length of pendant, and length of light chain).

**Sesuit Slip Holders** – all boat information must be exact length overall (LOA) which includes pulpits, swim platforms, outboard brackets and trimmed up outboard motor. This is the length of vessel that must be indicated on the application and paid for. **Not just registration length.**

## **Reminder**

All Sesuit Slip and Mooring holders please do not forget to make sure your license plate information is correct for your free parking sticker. Additional stickers are available at Town Hall for \$18 per vehicle. **All stickers must be affixed to vehicles as outlined in the Waterways Regulations.**

## **Sesuit Harbor Utility Turn Off Date**

In order to facilitate the winterization of the Harbor, all utilities will be shut down on **Monday November 1, 2010.**

## **VERY IMPORTANT REMINDERS**

**Please be familiar with ALL the Waterways Regulations – including: Section 3, Paragraph D & H:**

**D.** Tenders, skiffs, dinghies and other small vessels shall be aboard vessels or places where the Harbormaster directs. All such small vessels shall carry identification number, marks or names, and pram sticker.

**H.** Fishing from Sesuit Municipal Docks and slip is prohibited with the exception of the east side boat ramp and the so-called west side commercial pier.

## **Section 6, Paragraphs E & F:**

**E.** For any vacancy exceeding 24 hours, the Harbormaster shall be advised in order to permit temporary use of the space for transients. Any transient fees will accrue to the Town.

**F.** Any vessel owner to whom a slip space is assigned must have his vessel in his slip no later than **June 15<sup>th</sup>** of each calendar year. If the owner does not have his vessel in his slip by **June 15<sup>th</sup>** of each calendar year, and if no written notification is received and approved by the Harbormaster by that date, the vessel owner shall forfeit his slip and such slip shall then be assigned to the next person on the waiting list. Mooring holders must be on their mooring by **July 1<sup>st</sup>** of each calendar year, and if no written notification is received and approved by the Harbormaster by that date, the vessel owner shall forfeit his mooring and such mooring shall then be assigned to the next person on the waiting list.

**All vessels must be removed from their slip/mooring by November 1 of each calendar year unless authorized by the Harbormaster.**

**Pump out facilities are located at:** Sesuit Harbor – at commercial dock, Northside Marina - the pump out can be accessed by pulling into the fuel dock or calling 508-385-3936 and Bass River Marina - can be reached on VHF ch. 71 or call 508-394-8341. Please make sure to fill out the log at the Sesuit pump out station (MEP/DEP/Coast Guard will all be looking at the log). **Remember Cape Cod Bay is a No Discharge Area and a fine of \$5000 will be assessed.**

**TWIC** – All licensed Captains must hold a valid TWIC card. The current USCG you hold is not valid without the Transportation Workers Identification Card.

All Captains' licenses must have a copy kept on file at the Sesuit Harbormaster's office. Running a boat for hire without a USCG license will result in loss of a Town slip.

Moorings that are hauled out of the water must be inspected and sealed before placement in the water. Any mooring not inspected will be pulled as illegal moorings and your mooring assignment will be revoked.

## **Insurance Certificates and Vessel Registration**

Please be advised, you will not be allowed to place your vessel in its' slip or on its' mooring until you have submitted a copy of **BOTH** the registration/documentation and the Certificate of Insurance. The name of both the registration/documentation and Insurance Certificate **MUST** match the name on your application. **WARNING**, if your vessel is placed in its' slip or on its' mooring before these documents are received, you will receive a \$35 per day illegal tie-up citation.
