Notice of Public Hearings
Proposed Ordinance Nos. 2026-03 & 2026-04

On February 4, 2026, at 4:00 p.m., the Cape Cod Regional Government (Barnstable County) Assembly of Delegates will hold hybrid (in-person and virtual) public hearings on Proposed Ordinance 2026-03, To authorize a budget transfer within the County's Fiscal Year 2026 Operating Budget, as enacted in Ordinance No. 2025-03, in the amount of \$70,000, for the general fund operations of Barnstable County and Proposed Ordinance 2026-04, To authorize a supplemental appropriation to the Fiscal Year 2026 Operating Budget, as enacted in Ordinance No. 2025-04, including one-time and new initiatives, in the amount of \$200,000, for the purpose of funding a Federal Indirect, Internal Indirect and External Rate Study. The public hearings will be held in the Mary Pat Flynn Conference Center at the Barnstable County Courthouse Complex, 3195 Main Street – Route 6A, in the town of Barnstable, and via Microsoft Teams. The hearings will be open to anyone wishing to testify or make public comment on the proposed ordinances. The full text of the proposed ordinances has been electronically distributed to the Town Clerk of each town in Barnstable County. They are also available on the Cape Cod Regional Government website.
