## Hybrid Public Hearing CAPE COD COMMISSION

The Cape Cod Commission will hold a hybrid public hearing on **Thursday, March 5, 2026 @ 3:00 p.m. in person** (at the Mary Pat Flynn Conference Room, 3195 Main Street, Barnstable, MA 02630) **and virtually** (online and by telephone) to consider the Commission certification of The Town of Yarmouth's Local Comprehensive Plan, which was adopted at a Special Town Meeting on November 17, 2025 and will be reviewed by the Commission pursuant to Section 9 of the Cape Cod Commission Act and Section IV of the Commission's Local Comprehensive Plan regulations.

**Note:** The hearing will be held in a hybrid format, pursuant to Chapter 20 of the Acts of 2021, as amended by Chapter 2 of the Acts of 2025.
