No update or comments from the Chair.

Director. 2025 admittance to the Transfer Station WILL BE STICKERLESS. The system is working well at the Transfer Station. There is a new manager for stickers at town hall where the main problem is Data Entry. Chad is still having to do a lot of corrections. Sales will be on line and are checked and corrected at entry.

Going stickerless will be a savings of about \$2000!

Covanta is now Reworld. 2025 price increases have not been announced but we can expect a 5 to 10% increase.

The loader is out for repairs . A roll-of and front end loader are included in the budget. It is suggested that we use our Cap Fund. Also proposed that we bond and pay yearly out of the fund. The bond issue takes a 2/3 vote at Town Meeting. The finance director is on board.

A new electronic message board is coming. It is being funded with RDP points.

TS Foreman. Inside projects are being done due to the cold/windchill.

DEP reports are completed for the year.

Grants are due by February 15.

HazMat reports are due March 1.

Will be fully staffed on February 1.

The turnover to CMRK is in progress. This will mean that we have only one donation trailer not BayState textiles, Red Cross and Goodwill. The company also offers home pickup by request. The frequency of those pickups is important.

The minutes of December 2024 were moved by M Kyrimes with a 2nd by J O'Connor with unanimous aye votes.

Next scheduled meeting will be February 28th if needed.
