5:06 PM Chair Connie Mooers called the meeting to order.

5:06 PM 9 Chase Ave update regarding the Select Board meeting on 1/24. Mr. Healy came before the Committee for access over Depot Street beach. Committee reviewed the plans for the project. Kathy asked about the length of the wall. Mr. Healy showed the committee where the metal wall is and where the work is being done. Helene asked if the beach access policy guidelines have been met. Yes, all of the items have been completed. How long will the project take? Seven days. Window of time for the work to be done is 3/1-4/15. Helene Savicki made a motion to recommend to Select Board to accept petition as written and grant access over the beach as indicated. Mary Marvullo seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

5:25 Beach Maintenance---Excavator and front-end loader at Corporation Beach for annual dredge. Frozen shark at Cold Storage beach. Dustin is finding out how to dispose of this. Haigis Beach---approval to fix hole in the wall which was damaged from a storm. Will be an emergency fix. Corporation beach ---needs sand replenishment. With approval, it could be done the first week of March.

5:39 Review of Minutes of 1/12/23 meeting---Helene asked to add the words "and committees" to the sentence "the work was started before going to all the appropriate boards." Kathy Moorey made motion to accept the minutes as amended. Sharon Deane seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

5: 40 9 Chase Ave-- Connie asked if we can review the "over town property" access policy. Dustin will send the policy to the committee and we will review the plan for any comments to the town.

5:41 Budget review---had to be level-funded. 5 items were added. Dustin requested mileage reimbursement increase, port-a-john line item increase, salaries---recreation director position change to assistant beach and recreation director. This allows weekend coverage to be staggered among three people. This also helps with a good succession plan. Dustin also requested an overtime budget for the assistant beach and recreation director and office manager and an increase of the hours of the beach coordinator from 900 hours to 1200 hours. Connie expressed our appreciation for Dustin's leadership and that the staff wants to work for him and for the town.

6:00 PM BMAC meeting will be held on 2/27.

6:01 Access over South Village beach---the work is completed.

6:02 Bath house at Glendon Durling beach---will have port-a-potties this year.

6:02 Annual Town Report—change words of “gross revenue for 2022” to “gross revenue for beach season 2022”.

Mary Marvullo made a motion to adjourn. Kathy Moorey seconded. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned 6:04 PM.
