

**TOWN OF DENNIS
TOURISM COMMITTEE
MEMBERSHIP AND CHARGE**

Committee Membership

The Board of Selectmen shall appoint a committee to be known as the Tourism Committee hereinafter referred to as the Committee. Said Committee shall be composed of seven (7) Dennis residents and registered voters to be appointed to three (3) year staggered terms. The Committee shall include one (1) representative from the Dennis Chamber of Commerce and two (2) alternate members for a total of 7 members.

The Committee is charged with enhancing and promoting tourism within the Town of Dennis.

The Committee shall make appropriation recommendations to the Board of Selectmen through the Town Administrator. The goal is to have a reoccurring budget each year to be voted at a Town Meeting.

The Committee shall work closely with the Dennis Chamber of Commerce, the Economic Development Committee, the Dennis Port Revitalization Committee, local businesses and State and regional tourism agencies to sustain and enhance economic activity throughout the year in the Town of Dennis.

All meetings are to be held in a public location, properly posted and open to the public, in accordance with the Massachusetts Open Meeting law. Minutes of each meeting shall be prepared and approved by the Committee within thirty (30) days of any meeting and distributed to the Board of Selectmen. Committee members shall be mindful of their attendance obligations at Committee meetings as identified in Section 5-10 of the Town of Dennis By-Laws.

As stated in Article VII, Removal of Appointed Officers

Failure to attend meetings.

Where not inconsistent with Massachusetts General Laws, any appointed official who is a member of a multi-member board, committee or commission may be removed by the appointing authority after a public hearing for failure to attend more than three consecutive meetings. Failure to attend, if not adequately explained to the satisfaction of the appointing authority, shall be considered cause for removal.
