What is happening?

The proposed project consists of the rehabilitation of Main Street, (Route 28) and the addition of sidewalks and 5-foot shoulders to accommodate bicycle travel from Upper County Road to the Herring River Bridge.

How will this affect you?

Due to the context of the existing area and the potential for numerous negative impacts to abutters, the project only proposes 5-foot sidewalk and 5-foot shoulders on each side of Main Street separated by a grass strip
