STREET LIGHT STANDARD

Adopted by the Board of Selectman September 1, 2009

STANDARDS FOR EVALUATING the need for new street lights. Under these standards, no street light shall be ordered installed by the Town or its maintenance to be paid by the Town, unless it fulfills at least one category described in the following requirements.

- \_\_\_ A history of pedestrian or motor vehicle accidents that can be attributed to a lack of adequate lighting.
  
- \_\_\_ The combination of sight distance, roadway alignment, grades, channelization, or other factors constitute a confusing or dangerous condition if such roadway is not illuminated.
  
- \_\_\_ There is a significant volume of pedestrian traffic in crosswalks adjacent to frequently used public gathering places at night.
  
- \_\_\_ Street lighting for municipal or school parking areas or driveways or to be installed by the roadside in front of a municipal or school building where the vehicular or pedestrian safety of employees or the public will be served by street lighting.
  
- \_\_\_ Street lighting where it may aid in the protection of municipal or school buildings or public property from vandalism, theft, or other damage.
  
- \_\_\_ Intersections of well-traveled roads.
