

SUGGESTED PLANTS FOR DENNIS CEMETERIES

Criteria for plant selection: Matures at 4' or less
 Non-invasive
 Low Maintenance
 Tolerant of low soil fertility
 Drought tolerant (or moderately so) once established
 Known to be hardy on Cape Cod
 Roots non-threatening to stone stability
 Attractive
