1. Blueberry picking will be restricted to residents of Dennis and their families. Resident beach and dump stickers must be displayed or motor vehicle operator's license bearing Dennis address shown to attendant.
2. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult.
3. In order to operate and maintain the blueberry patch on a self-sustaining basis a nominal fee of 50 cents per quart will be charged.
4. Picking will be allowed between the hours of 8 AM and 12 noon on Wednesdays and Sundays. Checking in and out at attendant's booth is required.
5. Picking shall be for family use only. Limit 10 quarts per season.
6. Only authorized personnel will be allowed within the boundaries of the patch during non-picking periods.
7. "Cross Patch" will be under supervision during picking periods and will be subject to patrol by the Natural Resource Officer, Civilian Patrol and Police Department.
8. If for any reason in the judgment of the Natural Resources Officer, with the concurrence of the Chairman of the Conservation Commission, picking should be suspended, as, for example, during periods of high fire hazard, or a regulation need be altered, notice shall be made through the news media, and the closing of the entrance to the harvesting area be made in a suitable manner.
9. No vehicles, including bicycles and minibikes, will be permitted except in the parking area during picking periods.
10. No cook-out fires will be permitted. NO smoking allowed except in the parking area and at benches and tables.
11. Violators of the above rules and regulations, individuals committing acts of vandalism or littering will have picking privilege suspended and/or be subject to a fine up to \$100.00 for each offense plus the cost of repair of any damage as may be determined by the Conservation Commission.
12. Persons sensitive to poison ivy are advised to forego picking or use the utmost care to avoid contact.
13. The above rules and regulations are subject to change without notice.

This is to certify that the above Rules and Regulations for Conservation Areas were adopted by the Dennis Conservation Commission March 31, 1978 and supersede all previously adopted Rules and Regulations.
