DENNIS BOARD OF HEALTH

TOWN OF DENNIS PESTICIDE REGULATIONS

The purpose and intent of this regulation is to protect the fresh aquifer from which the Town of Dennis obtains its supply of portable water. Toxic contamination, caused by seepage of chemical compounds applied to ground surface to control unwanted vegetation and animal life existing or expected to exist thereon, is likely to adversely affect the public's health.

REGULATION:

The following regulation is adopted in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 111, Section 31, as amended Massachusetts General Laws, ter.ed.

"Application of pesticides whose manufacturer's label restricts application where ground or surface waters or public or private water supplies may be endangered shall be registered with the Health Department.

Homeowners, commercial and private applicators shall register the use of said pesticides with the Health Department, prior to December 31st, of each year."
