**POLICY RESPECTING FOOD SERVICE HOLDERS**  
**OF COMMON VICTUALLER LICENSES**

This policy, adopted by the Town of Dennis Licenseing Board shall apply to all current and future holders of Common Victualler Licenses, who also hold an alcohol license, under M.G.L. Chapter 140. This policy does not apply to holders of a General On-Premise License issued under provisions of Chapter 138, Section 12.

1. Holders of a common victualler license shall provide and maintain the facilities and implements for cooking, preparing and serving food.
2. Implements shall include, but are not be limited to, a stove and/or microwave oven, refrigerator, preparation area, storage area, hot and cold water in a three-bay sink or dishwasher.
3. Food shall be available to any patron during all times the establishment is open for the sale of liquor.
4. A limited menu may replace the full-service menu when the full-service menu is not available, said limited menu shall be submitted to the License Board or its designee for approval prior to implementation.
5. Food (limited menu) is defined as hot or cold sandwiches, salads, hot or cold hors d'oeuvres or other food items. Prices and minimum number of items to be reviewed by the License Board or its designee.
6. Popcorn, potato chips, peanuts and other snack foods shall not suffice as the basis of a limited menu.

This policy is effective July 11, 1989.
