

Burton N. Derick Historic Preservation Award

Nominations are being accepted for the **Burton N. Derick Historic Preservation Award**. This is an annual award that recognizes Dennis property owners who distinguish themselves by preserving and restoring the historic character of their homes and secondary structures including the land. Property owners and the public are invited to nominate candidates for this Award. Additional candidates are also selected by the Dennis Historical Commission.

The Award recognizes a range of finished restoration activities including preservation of the original architecture, adaptive reuse of historic structures, sensitive additions, landscape preservation and archaeology. All work should have been completed within the past calendar year

Properties must be at least 75 years old to be eligible. Primary emphasis will be given to a building's exterior preservation. The U.S. Secretary of the Interior's Guidelines for the Preservation of Historic Structures will be used to judge the nominations using the following criteria:

- *Preserving the historic and architectural significance of the property.*
- *Preservation or replication of historic materials and quality of project craftsmanship.*
- *Impact on the historic fabric of Dennis.*
