5:32 PM Meeting called to order. Review of minutes of 10/9/19 meeting. Remove Katie Clancy from October minutes. H. Savicki made a motion to accept minutes with Katie's name removed. P. Chatelain seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

New Business

5:35 Application for access over Bayview Beach for revetment repair at 6 Luscombe Lane Dennis. There was confusion at Selectman's Meeting about Don Munroe's application going before the Board of Selectman before coming to the beach committee. Mr. Munroe apologized for the confusion and accepted responsibility. An abutter talked about another time the replacement sand was not the same. There need to be mats in the parking lot. This property is owned by the Happiness Association. R. McGrath made a motion to recommend to BOS to accept petition with understanding that work would be done from 1/6/20 and finished by 2/21/20. Seconded by P. Chatelain. Motion carried unanimously.

Old Business

5:47 Plastic Bottle Ban---Connie thinks beaches should be exempt. We need more water filling stations. The discussion was about reconsidering the policy to make sure that the proposed policy will ban the purchase and sale of single-use, single serving plastic containers on town property, eliminating the word distribution.

6:13 PM BMAT---working on plover management by escorting cars instead of blocking off large parts of the parking lot. There will need to be staff there. Also, still looking at Dr. Bottero road, still working on permitting process.

6:16 PM Individual Working Groups---need to have Friends of Dennis Beaches to help the committee have a vehicle for funds for Memorials.

6:18 PM BSAM---BOS will be having executive session with town counsel regarding checking coolers.

6:19 PM Maintenance updates---bathhouse at Glendon Beach, new flood maps came in, need to go up another 5 feet. Looking at different options. On-going punchlist at Mayflower building. Final walk-through before final payment.

6:24 PM Budget and Capital---submitted budget---level funded. We will discuss putting things on capital next month. Questions regarding how the school budget is going to impact the overall budget.

6:27 PM Open Space and Recreation Plan---recommendations have to be in by next month

6:28 RFP for Concessions. RFP for Corporation Beach stated the number of tables has been cut from 18 to 10. Meeting amongst staff to review the RFP for all concession stands. Board of Health says the number of tables is exceeding the limit. Dustin has a meeting with Kristen from Board of Health. C.
