A **ReStore** is a recycling center/retail store that sells reusable and surplus building materials, appliances, furniture, and home accessories to the public, at significant discounts.

- **ReStore** is a “green” initiative by diverting house-hold goods and materials from our landfills.

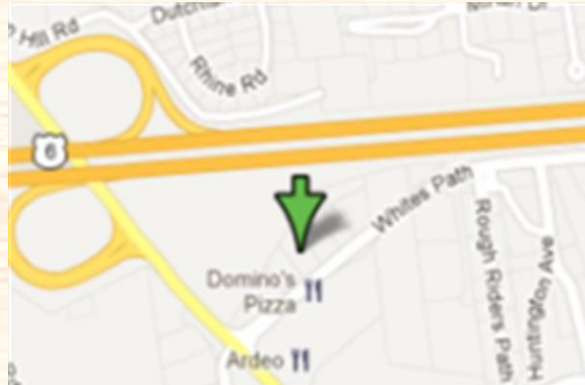
